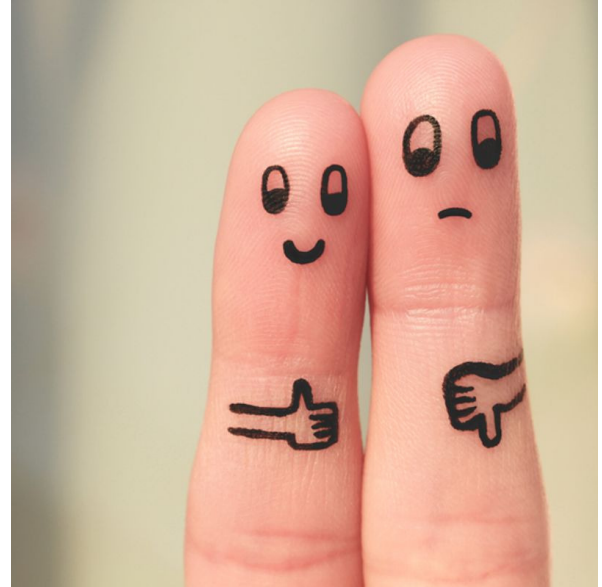

Like + (verb + -ing)

dance	We love dancing.	e + -ing
