We use the **past continuous** (I was trying) when we talk about an action in progress at a specific time in the past. We use the **simple past** (took) when we talk about a finished action in the past.

To form the **past continuous**, we use **was/were + -ing**.

The **past continuous** of *work*:

affirmative forms	negative forms	questions
I was working	I wasn't working	Was I working?
You were working	You weren't working	Were you working?
He/she/it was working	He/she/it wasn't working	Was he/she/it working?
We were working	We weren't working	Were we working?
You were working	You weren't working	Were you working?
They were working	They weren't working	Were they working?

Short answers

Yes, I was. / Yes, you were. / Yes, he was ...

No, I wasn't. / No, you weren't. / No, he wasn't ...




