Presentation: So and neither

We use **so/neither + auxiliary verb + I** to show that we have something in common with another person.

We use **so + auxiliary verb + I** when we agree with **positive** statements.

"I'm hungry." - "**So am I**".

When there is **no auxiliary verb**, we use **do** when we reply.

"I like ice-cream." - "**So do I**".

We use **neither + auxiliary verb + I** when we agree with **negative** statements.

"I'm not hungry." - "**Neither am I**".

"I don't like football." - "**Neither do I**".

The reply should be in the **same tense** as the **first statement**.

"I **liked** the film." - "So **did I**".
