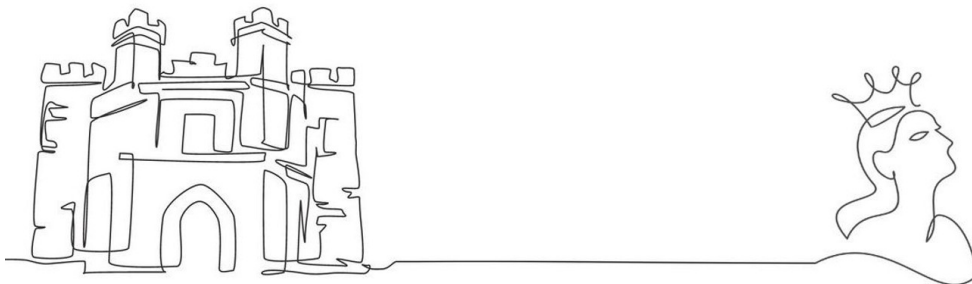

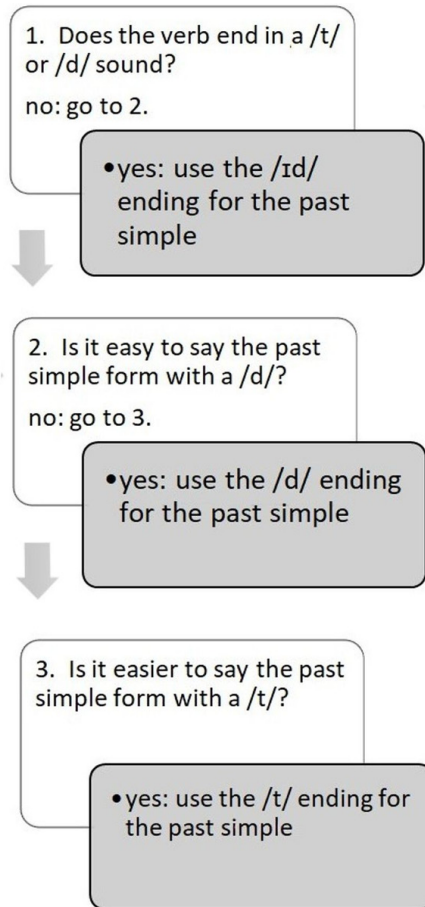

2. Listening

Reader: Diana Spencer was born on July 1, 1961, in Norfolk, England. She had an older brother and sister. Her sister Sarah dated Charles, the Prince of Wales, for a little while, and Diana met the prince for the first time in 1977 when she was just 16.

Reader: After finishing her education, Diana took a job at a school in London. She and Prince Charles began dating, and in February 1981, they announced their engagement. They got married in July of that year. Hundreds of millions of people around the world watched the wedding on TV.

Reader: Charles and Diana had two sons: William, born in 1982, and Harry, born in 1984. During the 80s and early 90s, Diana worked hard as a member of the royal family.

Reader: She received lots of attention from journalists for her hair and clothes, and she helped lots of charities. However, she also became very unhappy and realized that there were problems in her marriage.

Reader: She didn't want to stay in the royal family. Diana wanted to tell people how she felt. In 1992, she worked with a writer called Andrew Morton on the book "Diana - Her True Story".

Reader: She also gave a famous television interview in 1995 and spoke honestly about why she was so unhappy. A year later, she and Charles divorced.

Reader: After the divorce, Diana continued her work with charities. She was a good mother and took her two sons to see how people lived outside of the palace. Journalists followed her all the time. In August 1997, there was a terrible car accident in a tunnel in Paris.

Reader: Diana was killed, along with a friend and her driver. Her family, the country, and people around the world felt very sad about her death.

Go over the instructions and ask students to read through the text first to get an idea of the content without writing anything. This is excellent exam training for text-based exercises. Students can work alone, check answers in pairs, and then check with the whole class. Make sure students are pronouncing the regular forms accurately.

NOTE: If students are finding this difficult, skip the speaking stage and do the extra practice/homework exercises in class for additional support.

5. Speaking

Go over the context and instructions and set up A/B pairs. Make sure students are looking at the correct worksheet for their role. Go over the introduction, instructions, and example. Give students a few minutes to prepare their questions, starting with the words they are given. Note that they need to use mainly past simple, but also present simple. Students could work in A+A and B+B pairs to do this. Monitor and support as necessary. Students also need to read through text 2 so they are ready to answer their partner's questions.

Then students recombine into A+B pairs and ask and answer questions to complete their texts. Encourage students to ask for repetition or help with spelling from each other. They should not show each other their papers. Again, monitor and support as necessary and make a note of any errors for feedback later.

Early finishers can discuss the follow-up question.

Conclude this stage by checking some or all of the questions and answers or by offering error correction and feedback.
